
Are you worried about being evicted?



Evicted means being made to leave your home.



If you rent your home, you have been given greater protection against eviction.



Your landlord needs to give you 6 months' notice.



If you are struggling to pay your rent, get help as soon as you can.

Extra money



If you need extra money, there are 3 funds:



 <u>Discretionary Housing Payments</u>: This is if you rent your home, get Housing Benefit or Universal Credit, and need extra help to pay your rent.



Exceptional Relief: This is if you get Council Tax Support and who need extra help to pay your Council Tax.



 The Crisis and Care Award: This is extra help in an emergency or a disaster.
